Companies House data issues

We regret to report that we are still having issues viewing certain data on the Companies House system. We first noticed problems after the major system upgrade last October when it became impossible to search for directorships of certain directors. As far as we know this issue has not yet been resolved. We have also had reports of other anomalies which are affecting our company search service:

Mortgages for Northern Irish companies not showing
Documents being omitted from search packages
Duplicate entries on the Officers Database

We have so far managed to smooth out a number of issues through our close relationship with Companies House and are always pleased to assist our clients.

Reduction in capital – fees reminder

For reductions in capital by solvency statement, new registration fees of £10 (standard service) and £50 (same day registration service) apply from 6 April 2010. This procedure, introduced on 1 October 2009, is proving to be a very popular method to cheaply reduce share capital – which includes the share premium account and the capital redemption reserve.
